
#### **NEW and IMPROVED Monthly Reporting Plans!**

Several outpatient dialysis users noticed changes to the Dialysis Monthly Reporting Plan after the launch of the Dialysis Component in August 2014.

# What is a Monthly Reporting Plan anyway?

A Monthly Reporting Plan allows NHSN users to select the types of surveillance they will conduct according to CDC-defined protocols. This is called "in-plan" reporting. In-plan reporting of Dialysis Events is required to meet CMS ESRD QIP criteria.

Filling out a reporting plan also ensures that users will receive reminders (aka "Alerts") if they have not reported all in-plan data for a month. The reporting plan will also trigger warnings to prompt users to correct potential errors and address any missing fields.

Therefore, the reporting plan helps users report completely and correctly, in accordance with the protocol.

1. <u>HAND HYGIENE</u>: Users now have the option of reporting audits of "Hand Hygiene" under "Prevention Process Measures." The training and instructions for monitoring and reporting hand hygiene data have been posted to the NHSN website:

If your facility decides to perform hand hygiene surveillance, select your location under "Prevention Process Measures" on the reporting plan and start reporting! You will receive reminders and alerts from the system when hand hygiene data is due for a given month. In 2015, additional prevention process measures will be added to this section, so keep an eye out for our new resources!

2. <u>INFLUENZA VACCINATION:</u> Users can now track patient influenza vaccinations by reporting to the "FLUVAXDP— Influenza Vaccination Dialysis Patient" module! We have not yet posted our dialysis patient influenza vaccination instructions to the web, but please stay tuned! New resources will be posted here:

<u>3. CLIP EVENTS:</u> Users can report Central Line Insertion Practices (CLIP) events in NHSN! Reporting is optional; however, if your facility chooses to report CLIP events, detailed guidance can be found here: http://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/dialysis/clip/index.html.

Note: If your facility is interested in reporting data to a module "off-plan," you can do so by verifying that the checkbox next to the corresponding surveillance module is not checked on the monthly reporting plan for the given month(s) before reporting your data.
