The participant will then be able to present data to the staff, initiate process improvements at the facility level, and positively impact healthcare practices. This learning opportunity will enhance the knowledge and skills of the users in order to decrease healthcare-associated infections, improve patient safety, and enhance patient outcomes.

- 2. Outline the structure and methodology of the MDRO and CDI Module of NHSN
- 3. Define key terms and definitions used in data collection and reporting MDRO and CDI LabID Events
- 4. Identify the protocol for collecting MDRO and CDI data under the LabID Event Reporting Option
- 5. Explain the correct method for entering denominator data for FacWideIN LabID Event Reporting
- 6. Describe how MDRO and CDI LabID Event data can be used for performance improvement and patient safety
- 7. Describe the importance of interprofessional collaboration in healthcareassociated infection surveillance and reporting
