PHEP Budget Period 4

Operational Readiness Review Reporting Requirements

August 2022

CDC's PHEP Operational Readiness Review (ORR) implementation in Budget Period 4 (BP4) will focus on collecting recipient data related to select capability planning elements. In addition, **local Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI) planning jurisdictions will not be required to submit data in BP4**.

PHEP recipients must submit data on approximately 50 planning-related elements in BP4. These elements align with the operational data elements collected in Budget Period 3 (BP3) related to the Pandemic COVID-19 Incident Response (RSP). Collecting parallel data elements is intended to maintain the focus on pandemic lessons learned and to capture the current plans, policies, and procedures that PHEP recipients used or revised during the COVID-19 pandemic response.

Following is a summary of the planning elements, the <u>PHEP Operational Readiness Review Guidance</u> page number where recipients can find more detailed information, and the corresponding RSP element, if applicable. More information on responding to the questions is available in the ORR guidance in Appendix E: Answer Choice, Section 2: Evaluation of Plans.
