Once enrolled and before you can begin treatment in the World Trade Center (WTC) Health Program, vou must get vour conditions certified as WTCrelated.

What is a certified condition?

The Program certifies WTC-related health conditions that are in 5 main categories:

Disorders

Traumatic

Iniuries





Disorders

A certified WTC-related health condition is a diagnosed condition that is approved for coverage by the WTC Health Program. In order for a condition to be certified you must meet the Program requirements for certification described below.

Your health condition is included in the list of WTC-related health conditions

Your health condition and 9/11 exposures meet WTC Health Program policies and criteria for certification
